

BENEFIT ME!

As open enrollment approaches, here is a reminder about the pluntary benefits the District

additional voluntary benefits the District offers:

- Voluntary Short-Term Disability You can "buy-up" to a 14 day elimination period for short-term disability. If you are planning on having a baby next year, this is a great option to receive some benefits if you do not have much leave saved.
- Voluntary Life Insurance Do you have enough life insurance? Will your loved ones need resources in the event of your death? You can purchase additional life insurance for yourself, spouse and/or children. Restrictions apply.
- Worksite Insurance Most of you have probably seen the commercial with the Aflac duck. The district offers similar supplemental insurance for cancer, critical illness, and/or accidents.

Think of open enrollment as the time to revisit your current benefits to make sure you take full advantage of everything offered. Ask yourself the following:

How have my needs changed this year? If you are in your early 20's you may have been on your parents' health insurance, but if you are turning 26 you will need to get coverage. Have your children started daycare? If so, you may consider enrolling in a flexible spending account.

What insurance do I actually need? If you rarely go to the doctor, you may want to consider the \$3,000 high deductible health plan with a health savings account. If you are an extreme sport participant, you might consider the accident insurance.
